The Museum is located within the Park. Admission is free.

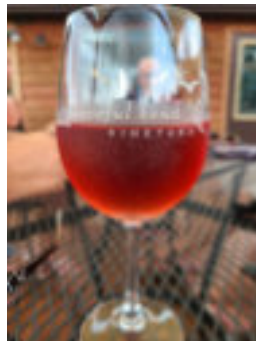
The Maramec Museum houses natural and cultural history exhibits.
